Don't Forget your Horse Health Declarations

DEPA has implemented a **Horse Health Declaration Form**; this is not a Vet check. This is a personal declaration to say to your best knowledge; your horse is well and no threat to others. Anyone entering the grounds either for a club event or for private use with their own horse, will need to present upon arrival at the grounds, a Horse Health Declaration Form. You will need to do an application to register for your PIC (property identification code) so that this form can be filled out correctly.

PIC Application

You can either go online at www.dpi.qld.gov.au go to the horse section and you will find the Application to register for your PIC number.

You can also ring Maryborough DPI on 07 41211866 and they will be able to assist you.

To fill this out you will need the **Lot number** of the property that the horse is on and the **Plan Number**. **DO NOT RING THEM UNTIL YOU HAVE THIS.** You should be able find this on your rates notice. If you have your horse adjusted at someone else's property you will have to find out this information from the owner of the property.
